Cascade Clamp - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They began as a small machine shop in the beginning hiring 4 people. Sales for their initial year of operation totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and other components. Within 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to forty workers and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is among the leading international producers within the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new business to aggressively engage in new business possibilities. All through the last sixty years, the trade of material handling has grown into a very sophisticated field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade presently continues to develop as the premier provider of forklift attachments and different associated products. The business feels assured in their capability so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the global market.

During the nineteen fifties, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and sell its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was constructed in 1956, to be able to accommodate all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current center of operations. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached nearly \$2,300,000.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next manufacturing plant was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial move into the global world of the material handling industry as the business established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the business altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the continental USA to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are manufactured internationally thanks to a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This facility is built to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and the year 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of 5 companies, including the international leader in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
